
NAIDOC Week 2025




P&C Disco – Fluoro Fun!


Don't forget there are two exciting school wide competitions currently underway:

Exploring Music- Junior Primary

This term, Junior Primary students have been exploring the foundations of music through singing games, movement, and percussion activities. They have been learning to identify and respond to musical elements such as dynamics (loud and soft), tempo (fast and slow), and rhythm (patterns of sound and silence). These playful and engaging experiences have helped them develop listening skills, confidence in using their voices and instruments, and an awareness of how music can be used to tell a story or create a mood.

Ukulele- Middle and Upper Primary

In Middle and upper primary students have been developing their musicianship through learning the ukulele. They have focused on strumming techniques to explore rhythmic concepts, used chords as a foundation for understanding harmony, and performed known melodies both as a class and individually. Students have also begun composing their own simple musical patterns, applying their understanding of melody and rhythm creatively. Through these activities, they've built confidence in reading chord charts, playing in time with others, and listening closely in an ensemble setting. It's been a hands-on and engaging way to deepen their understanding of how music is structured and performed.

Choir

This term, our school choir has been working hard in preparation for their upcoming performance at The One Big Voice. Students have been learning a selection of songs along with accompanying choreography, while developing vocal technique, expression, and harmony. Their commitment and collaboration during weekly rehearsals have been impressive, and we look forward to seeing them represent our school with confidence and pride at the event




